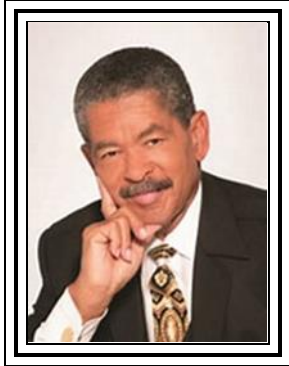


A Tribute to My "First" Pastor
